Footpaths and rights of way - Nothing to report.

Budock Village Hall – Budock Village Hall is open for business and operating to a reasonable degree. Not all the hirers have returned yet, but a goodly number have done so.

The present big issue is how the Committee can hand over the running of the Hall to the Custodian Trustees, this being because the committee cannot find individuals to take over the roles of Treasurer and Secretary.

There is a meeting of the Management Committee on 4 February which will be reported back on next meeting.

Treverva Village Hall – We are meeting Monday 31st Jan 2022. Bookings are creeping up with a few being potentially long term. Finances are healthy with grants from Council/Government securing the medium-term future of the Hall.

Playing Field – The Playing Field Committee had a successful Christmas tree lights switch-on despite the fact that the weather was terrible up until a short time before.

Peter Grounds kindly donated the tree, and it was lovely for the village to have an event again after the past two years. Next meeting is towards the end of February.
