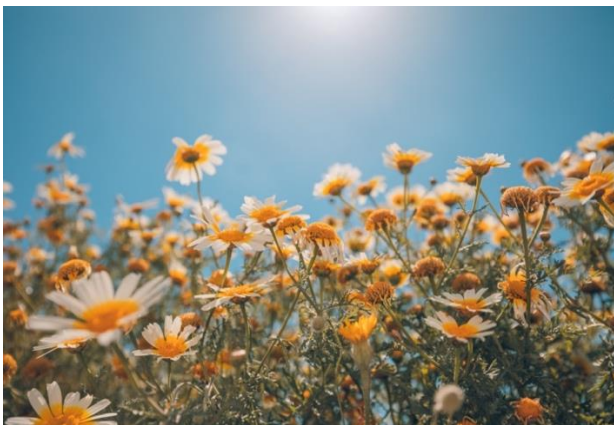

Royal Cornwall Show - Saturday 7th June 2025

Age Uk Cornwall & Isles of Scilly are offering a coach trip to this year's Royal Cornwall Show in Wadebridge on Saturday 7th June 2025.

Transport is provided (with local pick up points), to and from the showground, entry ticket to the show and a pasty lunch in the Age UK marquee at a reduced cost of £15.25 per person - the criteria being attendees must be aged 50+ and live in specified postcode areas - TR10-20 + TR26-27

Places will be on a first come basis. You must be physically able to cope with getting on and off a coach, manage the terrain of the Royal Cornwall Showground, and a significant walk from the Showground car park to our marquee and back. Individuals requiring support may be accompanied by a family member/carer, who will also be required to pay £15.25.
